Singing in Church




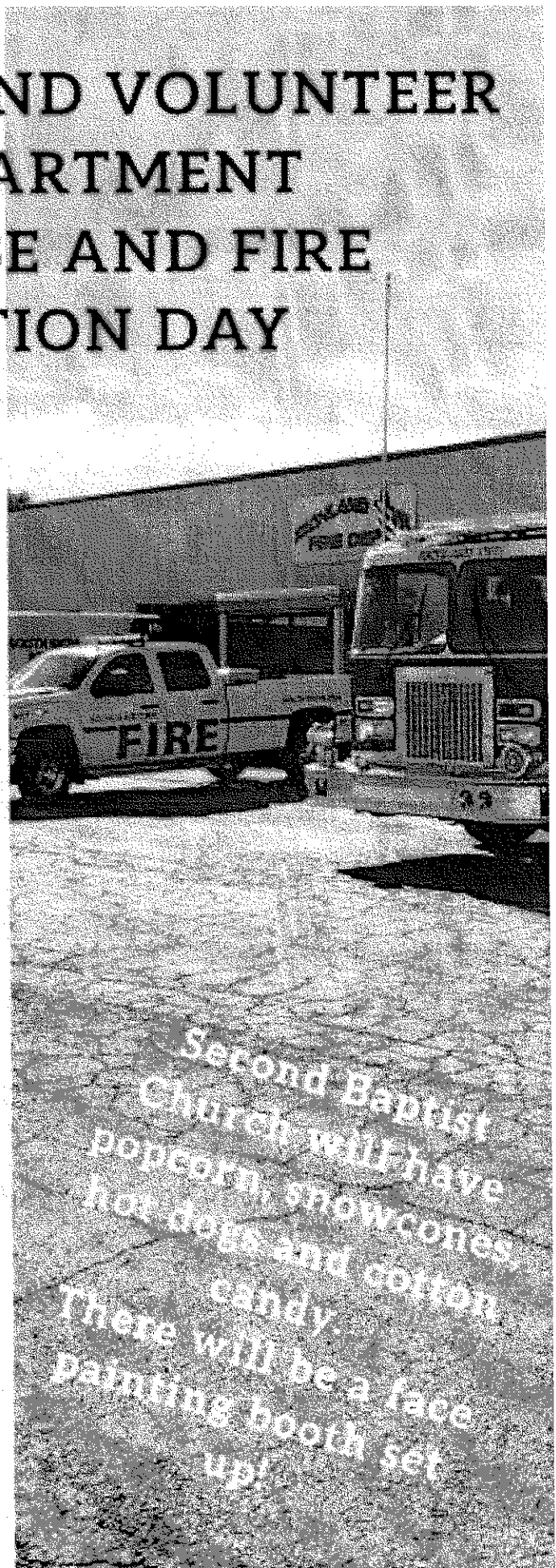
