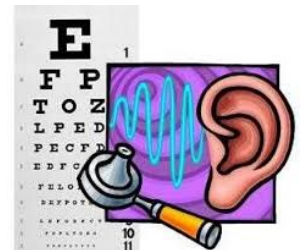


## Staff/Student Volleyball Game
