


2019 St. John Lutheran Church (SJL) Trunk or Treat



- Date:** Wednesday, October 30, 2019.
- Time:** Set up at 6:00 p.m. Trunk or Treat event 6:30-7:45 p.m.
- What:** Sponsor a table or car for Trunk or treat. Bring at least 100 pieces of candy (More will be provided) and set up your car/table with simple Fall/Christian Halloween decorations and bring your own table cover.
