

Come Walk with us! St. John PTL will have an awesome parade float in the Defiance Halloween Parade and you can join us!

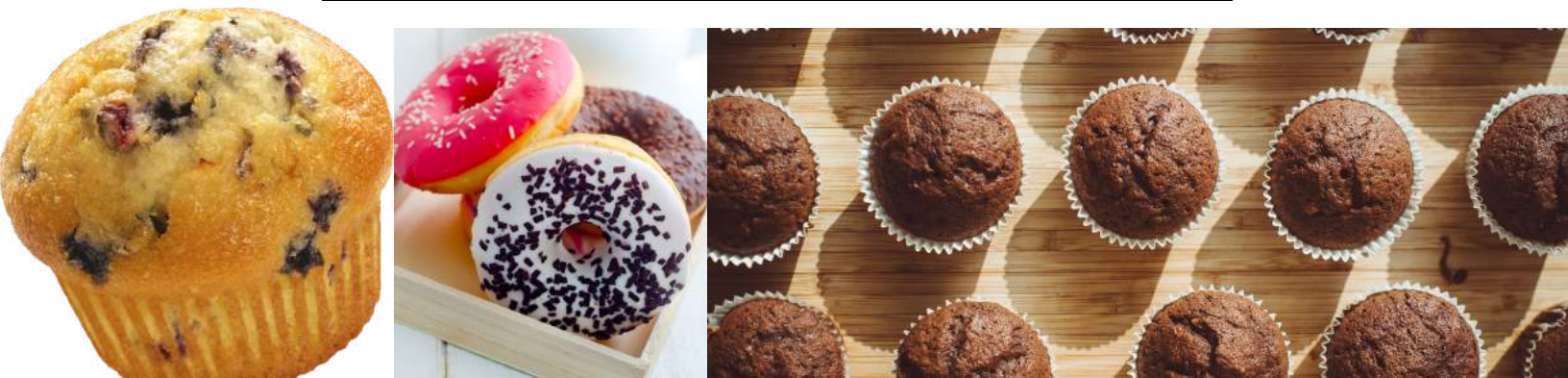
